Lesson Plan

Clans & Moieties

- Review chapter 3
 - How confident are you in introducing yourself? Practice giving your intro to yourself, your family, your pet, just to keep practicing. What do you wish you could say or add?
 - Take a look at the differing clans that make up Lingít aaní. Even if you don't have a clan, think about how balance is maintained and how important it is to help each other out, especially now.
 - Look at what the clan names mean, and see if you can see any patterns.
- Read pages 6-23 & 313-315 of *Haa Tuwunáagu Yís, for Healing Our Spirit* by Nora & Richard Dauenhauer (pdf's are provided).
 - Reflect on the balance of kin & the responsibility to take care of ourselves & others.
 - Pay special attention to the Lingít portion of George Davis speech. What kind of verb forms is he using? Highlight the verb roots as you read. Try reading the Lingít first and see how much you can follow.
