Taking a look at the verbs in this chapter (7 in *Beginning Tlingit* or 8 in the *Workbook*) pick a verb (or a few, though only 1 is required) that you want to master. Create flash cards of that particular verb in as many forms as you can find. The dictionary or Keri Edwards paradigm site: <a href="http://ankn.uaf.edu/~tlingitverbs/TlingitVerbsRoots.xml">http://ankn.uaf.edu/~tlingitverbs/TlingitVerbsRoots.xml</a> is a good place to start. Take scans, photo's or if you use an online flashcard create, provide a link, and send those to me via email. If you've found a site or method that really works for you, let your classmates know on the discussion board! Pick a verb that would be most useful, most memorable, or one that you just find interesting. Also note that often times the translation provided is not exactly the way it's really meant in Lingít so keep that in mind. Also keep in mind the underlying form, or those little parts that make the verb mean what it means in a particular form.

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
